

2025: A year of construction in the Portuguese-speaking world

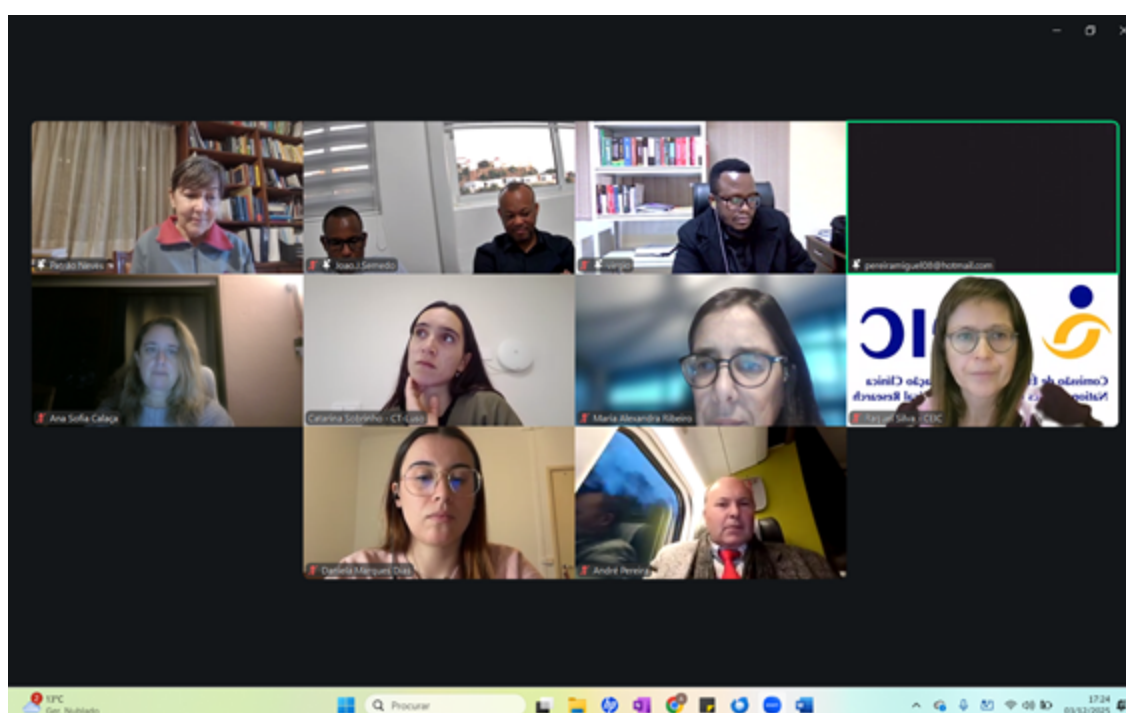

Training in Good Clinical Practices reinforces quality and ethical standards.

As part of the technical skills enhancement of the CT Luso project, the **training program “Good Clinical Practices | ICH-GCP (R3) Guidelines”** has begun, running from **December 2025 to June 2026**, in partnership with the Ethics Committee for Clinical Research (CEIC) and INFARMED. The initiative, which includes **135 trainees**, is aimed at professionals from drug regulatory authorities, ethics committees, researchers, research technicians, sponsors, and research centers.
