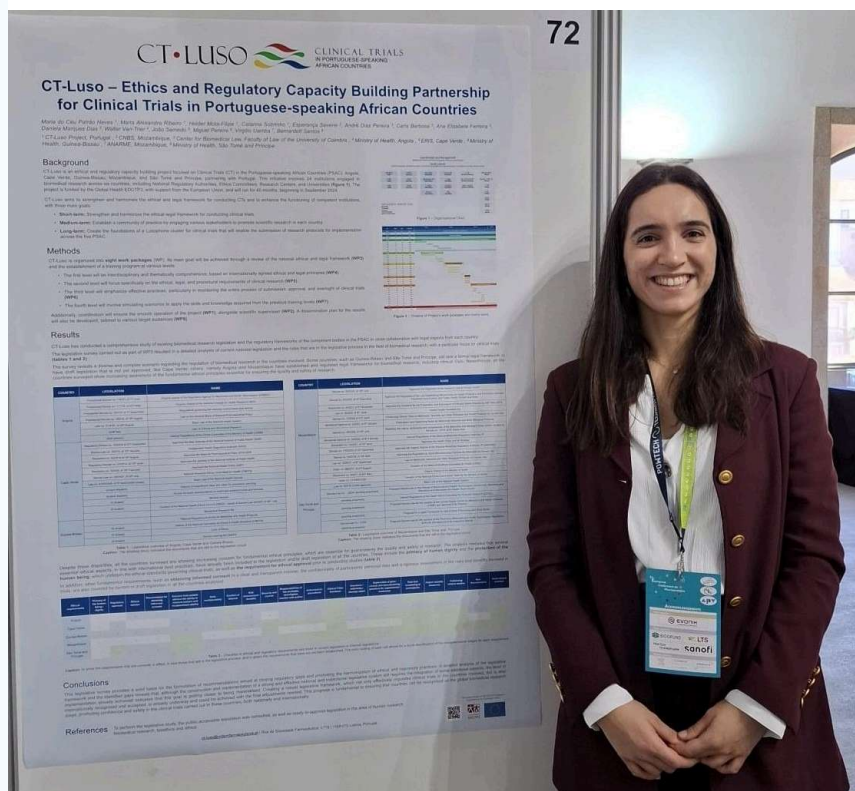

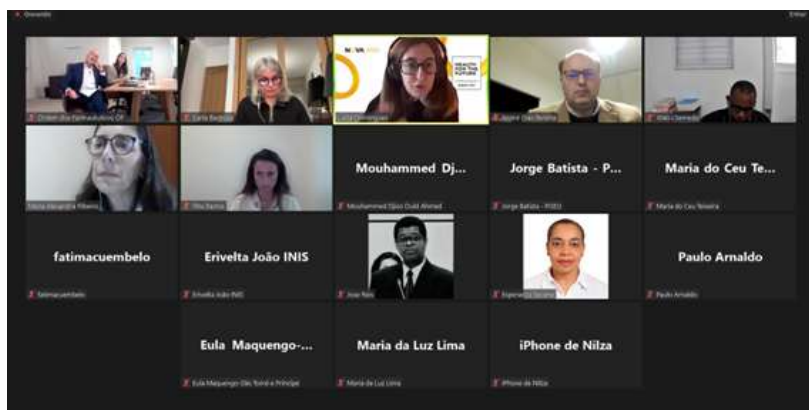
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### Poster presentation at the 5th European Conference on Pharmaceutics in Porto

The CT Luso project was present with a poster presentation at the **5th European Conference on Pharmaceutics**, which took place on March 24th and 25th at the Porto Congress Center. The main results of Action Plan (WP) 3 were highlighted, which systematizes the legislative survey on the ethical and legal requirements for the development of scientific and clinical research in the different Portuguese-speaking countries.
